The Watershed Farm is an adaptive reuse effort completed by the Loyalhanna Watershed Association (LWA) in 2016. Originally built in 1885, the farm was home to the McConnaughey Family until 1999. Shortly thereafter, LWA acquired the property to maintain it as farmland and greenspace at the western gateway to the Ligonier Valley. In 2010, LWA began a six-year effort to restore the farmland and structures.

Directions to LWA From Route 30 traveling West:

As you travel through Ligonier, you will travel straight through a stop light at Fort Ligonier (on right) and continue straight through the next stop light at the Giant Eagle (on right). After passing the Giant Eagle, you will make the next right at the blinking yellow light. After turning off Route 30, make the immediate left onto Old Lincoln Highway. The driveway on your right takes you up the lane to the office, located in the brick farmhouse.

From Route 30 traveling East:

As you travel towards Ligonier, you will pass by Idlewild Park and Ligonier Camp & Conference Center's Lake (on right). Take the first left exit into Ligonier. Continue straight through the blinking red light, crossing over Route 30 West. Make the immediate left onto Old Lincoln Highway. The driveway on your right takes you up the lane to the office, located in the brick farmhouse where there is limited parking. Our meeting will be in the white barn to the left of the farmhouse. There is no parking at the barn.

All parking is below the house and barn in the lot. Shuttle service will be available to the barn.
